We also plan a day-trip or day and overnight to Dorset to visit the Earl of Shaftesbury and his family at St. Giles House, his manor house that has been under restoration and featured recently in *World of Interiors* magazine and on the cover of the new Rizzoli book by James Reginato "*Great Houses, Modern Aristocrats.*"

2018 and beyond . . .

- ___ CUBA: Havana – We will continue with our trips, and will put together a “Cuba 2.0” for past travelers that want to explore more in-depth. This will be lead by Hermes Mallea.
- ___ MUSEUMS OF THE MIDDLE EAST - Qatar | Iran | United Arab Emirates -
Sat., 14 April to Mon., 23 April 2018 Ten nights total are envisioned - *note this trip is in the planning stages*, but the starting date is set for Saturday, 14 April to begin the program. We start in Doha, Qatar (non-stop flights from many US cities for departures on Friday, 13 April or before) where we will explore I. M. Pei's Museum of Islamic Art, along with other aspects of this contemporary city. Then fly up to Iran with Tehran and Isfahan visited for five or six nights, then end in Abu Dhabi in the UAE for experiencing the some of the five new museums on Saadiyat Island including Jean Nouvel's Louvre, Frank Gehry's Guggenheim and others. Travelers can either depart back to the USA from Abu Dhabi, or they may wish to go 1½ hours up the coast to experience Dubai – as both cities offer incredible architecture to see and explore – and both have excellent non-stops to the USA.
- ___ ITALY: Vicenza and the North - October 2018.
This is still in the planning stages - We'll be combining opera and architecture on this exciting journey. We will take part in the Opera Olimpica Festival and enjoy a performance at the Teatro Olimpico, constructed by the architect Andrea Palladio between 1580 and 1585 as the first enclosed masonry theatre in the world. *Stay tuned for more details.*
